Individuals who completed an ECITB Apprenticeship

To find out if you qualify for an SJIB Grade (ECS) Approved Electrical Fitters (ECITB) Card simply answer the questions and follow the arrows.

Have you completed a recognised four year apprenticeship and hold one of the following qualifications?

ECITB Diploma in Installing Engineering Construction Plant and Systems Electrical at SCQF Level 7; or

NQF/SQA equivalent accompanied with the applicable technical certificates etc from the ECITB frameworks; or

ECITB NVQ Level 3 in Installing and Commissioning Electrotechnical Systems and Equipment (Plant); or

ECITB NVQ Level 3 in Maintaining Plant and Systems (Electrical)

Have you had at least two years experience as a graded Electrical Fitter (ECITB)?

Can you provide certificates proving you have successfully completed the following:-

ECS Health & Safety Assessment (within the last 30 months) and/or hold a valid approved equivalent e.g. CCNSG Safety Passport. Click the [link](#) to see a list of approved equivalents

Complete and return a Up-Grade application form together with all relevant certificates/documentation, photo etc. to the SJIB and you will be graded as an Approved Electrical Fitter (ECITB).
