Datacomms Technician

Datacomms Technicians are responsible for the installation, commissioning and maintenance of structured cabling systems for datacomms systems. They must be able to demonstrate a wider knowledge and experience of the working environment and regulatory standards that work is carried out in.

In addition Datacomms Technicians must have Supervisory experience, knowledge of emerging technologies and be capable of designing network modifications. They must know the most effective and economical way to do a job and know how to apply the Electricity at Work Regulation 1989, 22-29 & 31 and the Construction Industry Regulations.

Datacomms Technicians must have:

- (a) Been graded as an Advanced Datacomms Specialist; and have at least three years' experience; or
- (b) Successfully completed an NVQ Level 3 in Electrotechnical Services Installation and Inspection Structured Cabling Systems and have three years post qualification experience; and have
- (c) Completed the ECS Health and Safety Assessment (within the last 30 months) or hold a valid approved equivalent
