

Advanced Datacomms Specialist

Advanced Datacomms Specialists are responsible for the installation, commissioning and maintenance of structured cabling systems for datacomms systems. They must be able to conduct testing of structured cabling, including all necessary containment as well as any associated connection units; installation and testing and bonding cables. In addition, they must be able to work as part of a team or independently.

Advanced Datacomms Specialists must have completed:

- (a) A Level 3 Datacomms Specialist apprenticeship; or
- (b) The City & Guilds Level 2 Award in Communications Cabling (3667); or
- (c) EAL Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Cabling Installations (601/3023/4); or
- (d) EAL Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Cabling Installations (QCF); or
- (e) A BTEC Level 3 Diploma in Professional Competence for IT and Telecoms Professionals; and have
- (f) Completed the ECS Health and Safety Assessment (within the last 30 months) or hold a valid approved equivalent.
