



ECS Health, Safety and Environmental Application

The SJIB **only** facilitate and invigilate the ECS Health, Safety and Environmental Assessment on behalf of individuals who are working through Recruitment Agencies, are self-employed or un-employed.

Important Note

The following cards have changed – Labourer, ECS Related Discipline, Senior Manager, Site Manager, Contract Manager, Office Staff and Visitors. Individuals who have held these cards in the past should now apply for the new Electrical Labourer, Operative, ECS Related Discipline, ECS Manager or ECS Site Support card.

The health and safety requirement for the new cards has changed. The ECS Health, Safety and Environmental Assessment will **not** be accepted as part of an initial application for the new cards.

Please refer to the new Initial Application forms to see the new health and safety requirements for each card.

Arrangements

- The SJIB are still currently working from home and for the time being, we will offer Virtual Assessments.
- You will be sent an email offering you this virtual assessment, you must reply to the person who emailed you.
- To proceed it is essential that you are competent and comfortable and that you can access Go to Meeting from your computer or lap-top.
- Please ensure that you have a webcam available as you will be required to have this on whilst taking the assessment as this is a closed book exam and the tutor will be invigilating you taking your test.
- You will need a note of your National Insurance Number at the start of the assessment.
- You must switch off mobile phones before entering the virtual assessment.
- You will not be admitted to the virtual assessment after it has started.
- You must be able to be seated in a quiet area, with no interruptions.
- Prior to commencing the assessment, I will ask you to provide photographic ID, e.g. Passport, Driving Licence or SJIB (ECS) Grade card.
- If, in the opinion of the Invigilator, you act in a manner likely to disrupt the Health and Safety Assessment, you will be disqualified and asked to leave the virtual assessment.
- If you finish the assessment before others, you are expected to remain quiet until all candidates have completed the virtual assessment.
- There is a Customer Satisfaction Survey which we would appreciate if you could complete, this will be emailed after the virtual assessment.
- If you have learning difficulties, or are unfamiliar or uncomfortable dealing with the assessment, please bring this to the attention of the ECS Administrator when you are booking the assessments and they will make alternative arrangements in a sympathetic and confidential manner.

SJIB GDPR Privacy Notice

In order to do this the SJIB are required to update and maintain your record of training, qualifications, SJIB grade(s) achieved over the years and applications.

This means that the SJIB would no longer be able to confirm your history of apprenticeship, SJIB grade(s), vocational qualifications, or any other qualifications to you or a potential employer/client/site.

Unless you specifically request the deletion of your records, the SJIB will retain these indefinitely as a record of your educational and professional attainment.
