

## **Datacomms Specialist**

Datacomms Specialists are responsible for installing and maintaining structured cabling systems for datacomms systems.

They must be able to carry out an installation of structured cabling, including UTP, STP, FTP, Co-AX, general common cables, single-mode fibre cables with all necessary containment and associated connection units and installation of earthing and bonding cables. In addition they must be able to fit out enclosures with structured cable termination equipment (connection units, hubs, switches, routers and panel patches).

Datacomms Specialist must have completed:

- (a) A Level 2 Datacomms Specialist apprenticeship; or
- (b) An NVQ Level 2 in Structured Cabling Systems; or have
- (c) At least two years' experience of the requirements listed above; and have
- (d) The employers endorsement and recommendation; and have
- (e) Completed the ECS Health and Safety Assessment (within the last 30 months) or hold a valid approved equivalent.
